

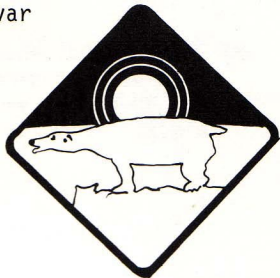

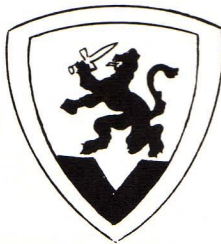

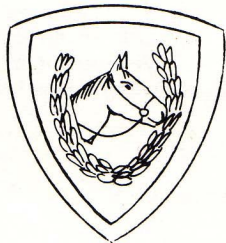

Woven.



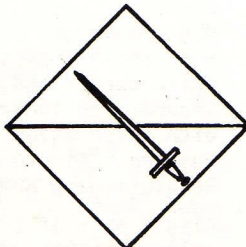

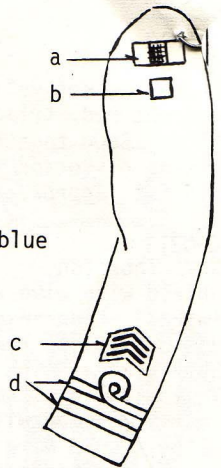

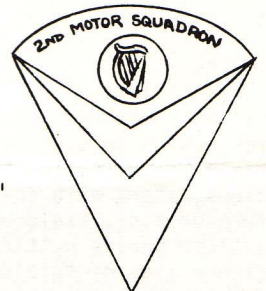
